ENCOUNTER/ARREST:

On July 31, 2019, Border Patrol Agents (BPA) assigned to the Beecher Falls Border Patrol Station, were patrolling the West Lebanon, NH area. For this patrol, agents utilized unmarked patrol vehicles and plain civilian attire with no badges or weapons visible.

At approximately 6:00 a.m., Patrol Agent in Charge (PAIC) [REDACTED] requested record checks on a Georgia plated [REDACTED] Ford F-250 that was located at the [REDACTED] in nearby White River Junction, Vermont. Record checks returned to a [REDACTED] from Doraville, GA. Further analysis revealed that [REDACTED] was an illegal alien from Mexico and the owner of [REDACTED].

Surveillance was initiated on the vehicle and it was followed to Summer Street in Hanover, NH. Agents continued surveillance until approximately 12:30 p.m. when the vehicle was again

<p>seen leaving Summer Street. The vehicle was followed back to the [REDACTED] in White River Junction.</p>		
<p>At approximately 1:15 p.m. PAIC [REDACTED] and BPA-Intelligence [REDACTED] encountered the vehicle at the [REDACTED]. At this time there was four subjects located in and around the vehicle. PAIC [REDACTED] and BPA-Intelligence [REDACTED] presented themselves as Border Patrol Agents and asked who the vehicle belonged to. All but one subject had a difficult time speaking and understanding the English Language. The subject that understood stated that the truck belonged to their boss. The subjects were asked where they were from and they all stated Mexico.</p>		
<p>Three of the four subjects stated that they were illegally present inside the United States without proper documentation. The driver of the vehicle stated that he was a Lawfully Admitted Permanent Resident (LAPR) which we were able to confirm through record checks. The other subjects identified as, [REDACTED] were all advised that they were under arrest for being illegally present inside the United States.</p>		
<p>The driver who was as LAPR was released from the scene and [REDACTED] were all transported back to the Beecher Falls Border Patrol Station for further processing.</p>

<p>At approximately 5:45 p.m. the same Georgia plated [REDACTED] Ford F-250 was seen leaving the area. PAIC [REDACTED] was also observing the area and was able to confirm that [REDACTED] was driving the Ford F-250. PAIC [REDACTED] had seen a photo of [REDACTED] earlier in the day that was obtained through record checks.</p>		
<p>BPA-Intelligence [REDACTED] followed the vehicle to I-91 South near White River Junction, VT. BPA-Intelligence [REDACTED] noticed that even though this same vehicle was encountered just hours earlier with four subjects, (three of which were apprehended and were currently in custody) there appeared to now be at least six subjects in the vehicle. Also when this vehicle was encountered earlier in the day, the bed of the truck was relatively empty. This truck's bed was now visibly loaded with suitcases, garbage bags, and other miscellaneous items.</p>		
<p>Due to the fact that this vehicle was registered to [REDACTED] an illegal alien who was believed to be driving the Ford F-250 and the fact that there had to be at least five new people in this vehicle, BPA-Intelligence [REDACTED] conducted a vehicle stop with the Georgia Plated F-250.</p>		
<p>Upon approaching the vehicle, BPA-Intelligence [REDACTED] identified himself as a Border Patrol Agent and noticed that there were six male subjects inside the vehicle. After a quick glance BPA-Intelligence [REDACTED] was also able to confirm that [REDACTED] was driving this vehicle. BPA-Intelligence [REDACTED] instructed [REDACTED] to turn the vehicle off and hand him the keys. BPA-Intelligence [REDACTED] asked [REDACTED] who the vehicle belonged to and he answered</p>

that it was his "company truck". BPA-Intelligence [REDACTED] asked [REDACTED] where he was from and he stated, "Mexico". When [REDACTED] was asked if had any U.S. visas or identification he handed over an expired Employment Authorization Card (EAD). BPA-Intelligence [REDACTED] asked the rest of the five occupants of the vehicle what country they were citizens of and they all stated Mexico.

BPA-I [REDACTED] individually asked all the occupants if they had any valid visa or immigration documents to be in the United States legally. None of the occupants could provide any valid documents and they all claimed to be illegally present inside the United States. Below are the names of the occupants of the vehicle:
